Mr. Abood stated that it was dark and he thinks there was water so it was hard to see and there were other potholes that were filled that he was trying to avoid and a car was coming and he had to hit it. He has pictures of it. It was large enough that the whole wheel fell in and they think that they heard the bottom of the car hit the road.

Mr. Stelmaschuk asked if they have had the new tires installed.

Mr. Abood stated no. He put tires off of another car that he put on. He took it to a place to get an estimate for the tires themselves and then he inquired about the rims because they have damage on the aluminum and he said that they won't know until they take it off and put the new one on and balance it. He doesn't think that they are damaged other than the cosmetic damage. He is checking to see how much that is too.

Mr. Stelmaschuk stated that right now he understands that he is looking for reimbursement for the tires.


Mr. Abood stated yes because the tires only had 4,000 miles on them.
