THE GREAT BROADVIEW HEIGHTS CLEAN-UP

Every Spring, The Litterbugz (a non-profit organization) organizes thousands of volunteers in Greater Cleveland to pick-up trash in the communities in one day. **It will be held tomorrow, Saturday, April 27, 2019. Gather at 12:30PM behind the Boneyard and Handels** in front of Petpetual Fitness (203 East Royalton Road). Volunteers grab trash bags, strap on rubber gloves, and spread out in groups of five. Each group is given a certain territory. Most trash is recycled. Volunteers divide trash into aluminum, plastic, and unrecyclable trash. Volunteers use trucks to haul away the trash. Every volunteer receives a green t-shirt that says "iHateTrash". Volunteers can receive discounts by wearing this green shirt into stores. SOLICITING IN BROADVIEW HEIGHTS

It's the time of year when solicitors begin their door-to-door sales. Section 828.04 of our Codified Ordinances limits the hours of solicitation from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Section 828.05 states that, "...no person engaged in business...shall call at any residence in the City which displays a NO-SOLICITATION sign. Section 828.06 reads: "Peddlers and solicitors shall use only residential sidewalks and driveways..." Section 828.07 reads: "...no person engaged in business...shall call upon...any residence...which is at that time on the 'Peddlers/Solicitors Do Not Call Registry.' If you do not want solicitors, please put a NO SOLICITING sign in a visible place on your door. If a solicitor ignores your sign, call the police at that time. Note: Even if you are on the [DO NOT KNOCK LIST](#), you need to have a NO SOLICITING sign on your door.

- **INFORMATION REGARDING THE MAY 7TH PRIMARY ELECTION:** Voters in Broadview Heights will cast ballots on a municipal zoning issue in the May 7, 2019 Election, known as **Issue 6**. Issue 6 is a proposed zoning amendment change in the City of Broadview Heights asking voters if they approve changing four (4) parcels from A1 Residential Family Zoning to Special Planning District Zone B zoning, which allows for denser housing. It reads: *Shall the Zoning Map of the City of Broadview Heights be amended to change the zoning classification of PP#'s 584-08-004, 584-08-005, 584-08-006 and 584-08-007, located on the North side of Route 82 between Seneca Boulevard and Oakwood Trail, from their current A-1 (Single Family Dwelling) to Special Planning District Zone B?* For more information, [read the Ordinance 1-2019](#) Rezoning Parcels located on the north side of Route 82 (PDF). • ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

- **WEST MILL ROAD** will be repaved starting Monday, April 22. Traffic will be maintained in both directions.

Each patented Deterra pouch contains a water-soluble inner pod containing proprietary MAT12[®] activated carbon. Once the drugs are placed in the pouch, warm water is then added, which dissolves the inner pod releasing the activated carbon. Deterra works on pills, patches, and liquids, allowing them to be adsorbed by the carbon, rendering them inert and non-retrievable. To receive a pouch, please call 440-526-4074.

- **MAY 7, 2019 PRIMARY ELECTION:** Voters in Broadview Heights will cast ballots on a municipal zoning issue in the May 7, 2019 Election. To make sure there are no problems on Election Day, voters should check their voting information to make sure they are registered at their current address. The deadline to register and/or update voter registrations is Monday, April 8, 9PM. Register online at <http://www.443vote.com>. Registration cards are available at the Board of Elections and all public libraries. Early voting is from April 9 through May 6 at the Board of Elections: 2925 Euclid Avenue,

Cleveland. Early voting hours are posted on the Board's website. Voters may also submit vote by mail ballot applications if they wish to vote from home. Registration for this notification service is customized, allowing residents to choose which alerts they would like to sign up for and their preferred manner of receipt. - **ITEMS THAT ARE NOT ACCEPTED AT OUR HAZARDOUS WASTE SERVICE GARAGE DROP OFF LOCATIONS:**
 - **LATEX PAINT** is NOT hazardous waste. Please dry it out at home and put with the regular trash with the lid off so the drivers can see that it is dried out. You can mix the paint with kitty litter, sawdust, or a purchased drying agent available anywhere that paint is sold.
 - **MEDICAL WASTE:** Unused medications can be taken to the North Royalton, Seven Hills, or Brecksville police departments and placed in the drug disposal box in their respective lobbies.
 - **CFL LIGHT BULBS** (the curly ones) should be taken to *Lowes, Home Depot, or Batteries+* for recycling (15312 Pearl Road; phone 440-571-0002 or 440-571-0016)
 - **FLUORESCENT TUBE LIGHTS** should be taken to *Batteries+*.
 - **PROPANE TANKS** (20 lb. regular grill tanks) can be taken to any business that sells Blue Rhino propane. Write "RECYCLE" on the empty tank.
 - **TELEVISIONS AND MICROWAVES** are NOT accepted in the computer round-up drop-off location! Tube televisions under 32", flat screens under 50", and portable televisions can be taken to any Best Buy for recycling (please call Best Buy ahead, fees may be charged).
 - **SINGLE-USE ALKALINE BATTERIES** can be safely discarded in your regular trash. Additional information can be found at <http://cuyahogarecycles.org>

CITY RULES & REGULATIONS

- **BUILDING DEPARTMENT REMINDERS:** All contractors performing work in the City must be registered. The majority of projects that require hiring a contractor also require a permit. Permits cards must be displayed on the property in a place visible from the street. Projects requiring contractor registration and permits also require inspections by the Building Department. Specific to roofers, an "ice guard" inspection is required prior to installing shingles. Contact the Building Department with any questions. 440-526-6864

- **MINORS CURFEW:** Per [Chapter 648.10](#) of the Broadview Heights Code of Ordinances the curfew age & hours are as follows:

Age	Hours
Through 12	Darkness to 6:30 a.m.
13 through 15	10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
16 through 17	11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday;
16 through 17	Midnight to 6:00 a.m., Friday and Saturday

- **CURBSIDE RECYCLING GUIDELINES:** **Simply put, listed are the items that are recyclable:** Plastic Bottles & Jugs, Glass Bottles & Jars, Cartons, Metal Cans, and Paper & Cardboard. Throw away the lids in regular trash unless they are still on the original container (tightly). **When in doubt throw it out (in the garbage that is).** Click on this link for tips on recycling the right way [Cuyahoga Recycles](#). - **NOISE ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO OUTDOOR EQUIPMENT:** No person shall use engine or motor- powered garden, lawn or maintenance tools intended for repetitive use in landscaping in residential areas, typically capable of being used by homeowners, including garden tools, riding tractors, walking tractors and power mowers, between the hours of 8PM of any day and 8:00AM of the following day. **Note: Hours vary for construction and roadwork.**
- **TRIMMING OF TREE LAWN TREES:** Please help us be a “walkable” community by pruning the trees on your tree lawn. The Shade Tree Commission recommends a minimum height of 6’6”. This will help keep our pedestrians and bike-riders safe.
- **ALL GARBAGE IS TO BE PUT OUT BY 7AM:** Due to weather conditions, holidays, call-offs, etc. the normal pick up times will vary. Do NOT rely on the time that trash has been picked up in the past.
- **SOLICITING IN BROADVIEW HEIGHTS:** There are several ordinances that pertain to [soliciting in Broadview Heights](#). All ordinances are located on our [website](#).
- **NO OVERNIGHT PARKING ON CITY STREETS:** [Codified Ordinance](#) section 452.05(c) (1) prohibits parking on city streets between the hours of 3AM and 6AM. Per Codified Ordinance section 452.20 (a), signs are posted at city limits.
