The City of Broadview Heights is taking precautionary measures to protect the health and safety of our residents. The City Hall will remain open during our regular hours of 8:30AM – 4:30PM, M-F. Human Services will continue to deliver Meals on Wheels and provide transportation to all scheduled medical appointments. All other activities within the Senior Center are canceled until at least April 3. The Human Services staff will be available for any questions. Please call 440-526-4074 if you have any questions. The Auxiliary Gym WILL BE OPEN for Election Day. Access to the gym is made available by entering through the side doors on the east side of the building. There will be signs by the doors. We are committed to providing a clean and safe facility for our patrons. We are proactively increasing our sanitation efforts within the Community and Recreation Center. While the facility is open, we ask that you do your part to slow the spread of germs:

- Stay home if you are sick
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth
- Cover your cough or sneezes with a tissue & properly dispose of the tissue
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces
- Wash your hands often, for at least 20 seconds
- Patrons utilizing exercise equipment should wipe down the equipment with the gym wipes provided after use. The ERC Wipes that are provided are proven to kill bacteria & viruses.

At-Risk Individuals: The Center for Disease Control (CDC) is advising vulnerable individuals to limit outings, avoid large gatherings, telecommute if possible, stay home if they are sick, and avoid people who are sick. Vulnerable individuals are those who are 60 years old and older; or have health conditions such as heart disease, lung disease, diabetes, kidney disease and weakened immune systems.
