**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A POLICY SETTING
A FEE SCHEDULE FOR BODY AND DASH CAMERA VIDEO REQUESTS MADE
OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT IN THE CITY OF BROADVIEW HEIGHTS AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, House Bill 315, which became effective on April 3, 2025 provides that law enforcement agencies are permitted to charge a fee to release law enforcement video records for inspection or production; and


WHEREAS, the City Council has determined it is in the best interest of the City to establish a policy setting forth a fee schedule for such video request made of the Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROADVIEW HEIGHTS, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized establish a policy setting a fee schedule for body and dash camera requests made of the Police Department in accordance with the law as set forth in House Bill 315.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason stated in the Preamble hereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) or more of the members of Council and the signature of the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
