**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PARTICIPATE IN THE
SANDOZ SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH RESPECT TO THE OPIOID
LITIGATION IN THE CITY OF BROADVIEW HEIGHTS AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City in the Sandoz Settlement Agreement with respect to the Opioid Litigation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROADVIEW HEIGHTS, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is authorized to participate in the Sandoz Settlement Agreement with respect to the opioid litigation as delineated in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part thereof as if fully rewritten.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare for the reason stated in the Preamble hereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) or more of the members of Council and signature of the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
