INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR ALAI AND THE ENTIRE COUNCIL

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER TO ADVANCE
THE SUM ALLOWED BY LAW FROM THE PROCEEDS OF TAX LEVIES IN THE
ACCOUNT OF THE CITY OF BROADVIEW HEIGHTS, PURSUANT TO SECTION
321.34 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Section 321.24 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that any money in the County Treasury to the account of the City of Broadview Heights and lawfully applicable to the purpose of the current fiscal year may be drawn upon by request, and therefore, the subject matter of this Resolution constitutes an emergency in that the same provides for the usual operation of a municipal department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROADVIEW HEIGHTS, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to Section 321.34 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Fiscal Officer of Cuyahoga County be and he is hereby requested to draw his warrant in the maximum sum allowed by law, and the Fiscal Officer of Cuyahoga County be and he is hereby requested to pay to the City of Broadview Heights said sum as an advance against proceeds of tax levies now in the County Treasury in the account of the City of Broadview Heights, and lawfully applicable to the purposes of the current fiscal year.

SECTION 2. The Clerk of Council is directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the County Fiscal Officer.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace, safety and welfare of the public for the reason stated in the Preamble hereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of five or more members of Council and signature of the Mayor, it shall take effect and be in full force immediately; otherwise it shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
