The original budget contained transfers from the General Fund to the Bond Retirement Fund (\$578,935), to the Fire Levy (Operations) Fund (\$225,000), the Storm Sewer Fund (\$200,000) and the Street Construction Maintenance & Repair (SCMR) Fund \$650,000. It also included a transfer from the Storm Sewer Fund to the Bond Retirement Fund (\$65,648.51).
