AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ADVANCING FUNDS

WHEREAS, certain funds need to be advanced as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROADVIEW HEIGHTS, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Finance is hereby and herein authorized and directed to advance the following sums from the accounts indicated into the accounts so indicated.

<u>FROM</u> Royalton Road TIF	<u>ACCOUNT NO.</u> 230-7780-52902	<u>AMOUNT</u> \$200,000.00
<u>TO</u> General Fund	<u>ACCOUNT NO.</u> 100-9000-49102	<u>AMOUNT</u> \$200,000.00

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety, and welfare for the reason stated in the Preamble hereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) or more of the members of Council and signature of the Mayor, it shall be in full force and effect; otherwise, it shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
