Youth Golf Lessons for kids ages 7-16 will be held at the Broadview Heights Indoor Golf Simulator. Participants will receive instruction on the basics of the golf swing, and the rules and etiquette of the game. Water Safety Instructor

This course trains instructor candidates to teach all American Red Cross swimming & safety courses except Lifeguarding.

Archery
